


POLAR Walkthrough- Incorrect Diabetes Coding

This walkthrough will demonstrate how to use POLAR to find patients who have a past history recorded of diabetes unknown type.

Step 1


Open POLAR under Reports select the Clinic Summary Report

Step 2



-Select Clinical then Diabetes QI



Step 3

-Select the Quick Filters DQI Cohort

You may want to select the patient filter RACGP Active if you only want to see patients that have been 3 or more times in 2 years. To do this:




-Select the patient filter on the left hand side -
-Select RACGP Active
-Confirm the selection

Step 4

Using the Most Recent Coded Diabetes table
-Select the Diabetes mellitus (unknown type)
-Confirm the selection.

Note: you may not have any if your GPs are coding Diabetes correctly.



Step 6

-Select Patient List to view patient names

-Select Export Data to export the Patient List to Excel

Export Data

You can further sort by provider and print if needed

These patients need to have their past history edited to the correct SNOMED code

of Diabetes Mellitus type 1 or Diabetes Mellitus type 2.
