


## POLAR Walkthrough- Identify patients who have an active diagnosis of diabetes unknown type.


### Step 1

Open POLAR under Reports select the Clinic Summary Report



### Step 2


Select Clinical then Diabetes QI



### Step 3

Select the Quick Filters DQI Cohort

You may want to select the patient filter RACGP Active if you only want to see patients that have been 3 or more times in 2 years to do this select the patient filter on the left-hand side and select RACGP Active and confirm the selection




#### Step 4

Using the Most Recent Coded Diabetes table select Diabetes mellitus (unknown type) and confirm the selection.

Note: you may not have any if your GPs are coding Diabetes correctly.

#### Step 5

Select patient list then export to excel for sorting. These patients need to have their past history edited to the correct snomed code of diabetes mellitus type 1 or diabetes mellitus type 2.
