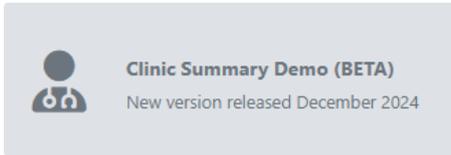


POLAR Walkthrough- Patients with Diabetes and no Hba1c measure recorded in the last 12 months

Step 1

Open POLAR under Reports select the Clinic Summary Report

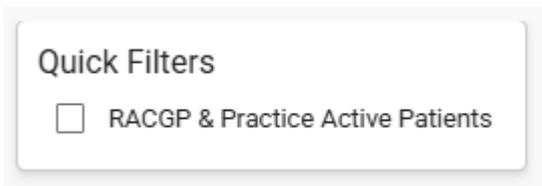

Step 2

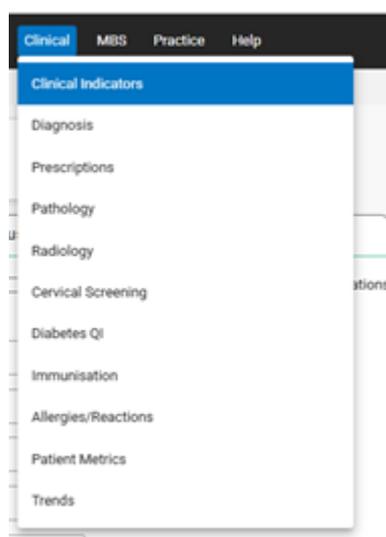
-Tick the box in the Use the Quick Filters box located at the top of the Dashboard.

Step 4

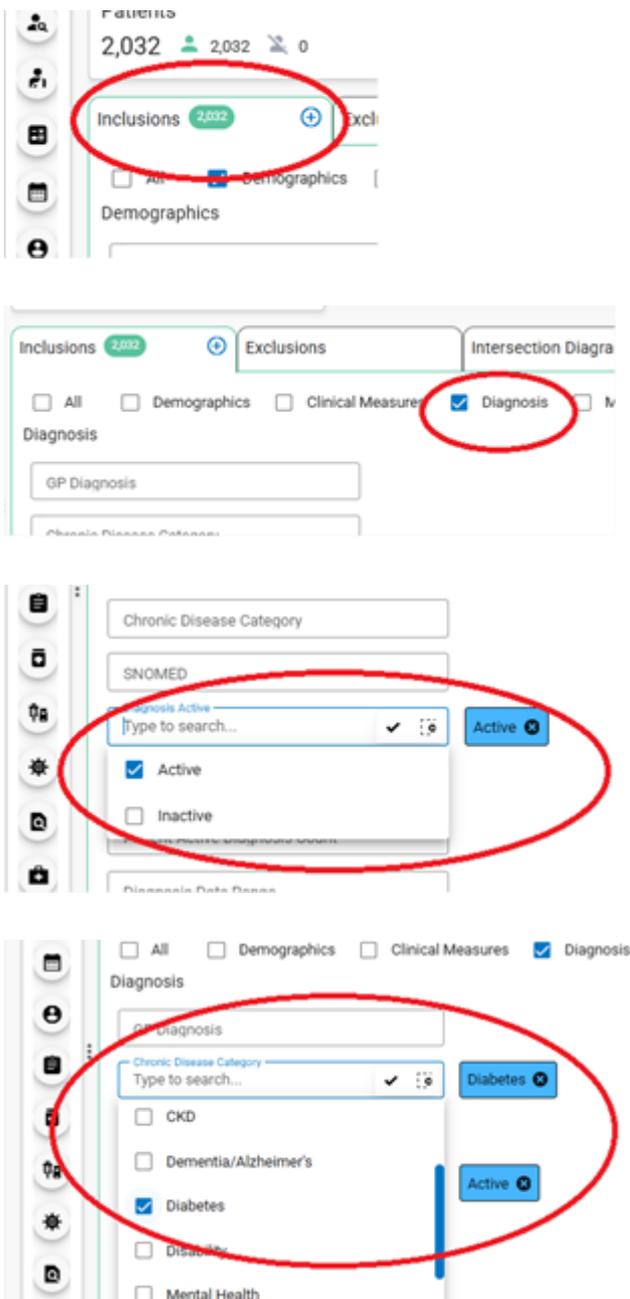
In the Inclusion filter tab:

-Confirm the selection.

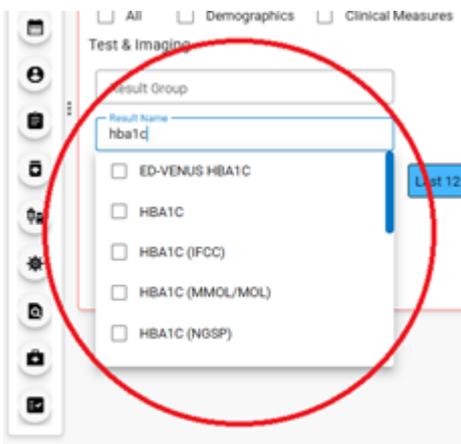
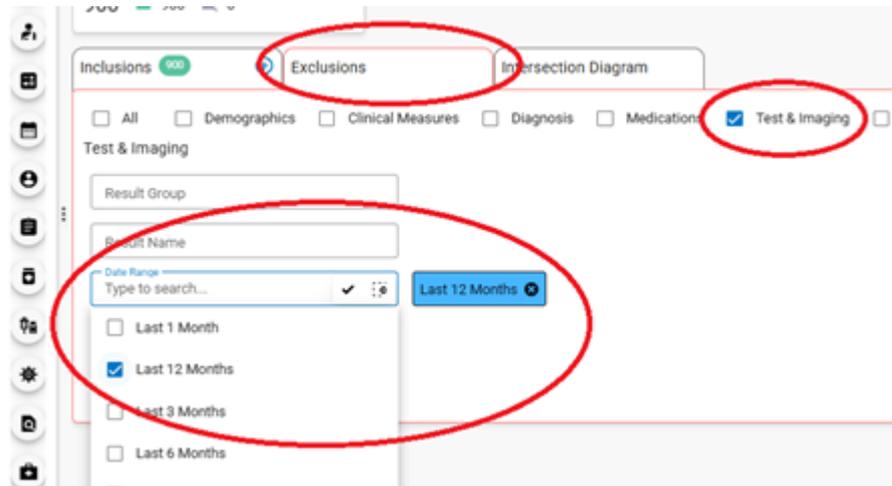

Step 5

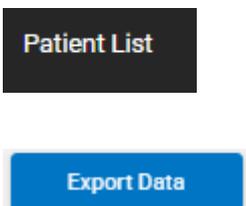
- Select the Exclusion tab.
- Select Test & Imaging.
- Select date range last 12 months.
- In Result Name
- Type in the search hba1c
- Select all the hba1c tests
- Confirm the selection.

TIP:- Instead of ticking all the boxes independently you can press the Enter key on the keyboard. This will select all the options with hba1c in their name.

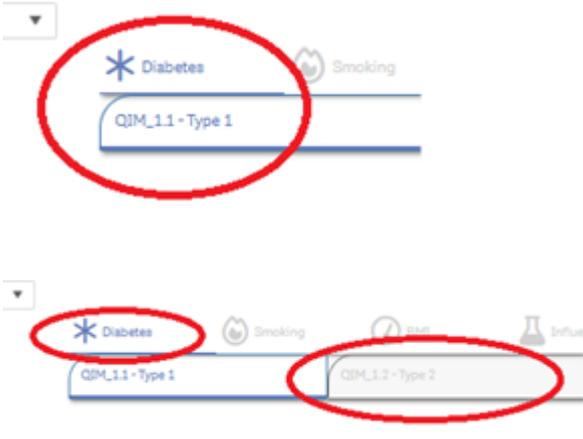


Step 6

- You can further sort by provider



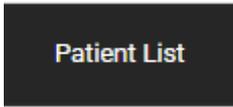
